<b>Research and present on an inspirational woman:</b> Research and present on an inspirational woman from history or present-day who has made significant contributions to society. Explore different fields such as science, art, politics, and sports.	
<b>Write a letter to a woman who has inspired you:</b> Write a letter to a woman who has inspired you, sharing what you have learned from her and how she has impacted your life.	
<b>Create a timeline of women's rights:</b> Create a timeline of women's rights, starting from the suffrage movement to present-day. Include important milestones and events, along with key figures who played a role in advancing women's rights.	
<b>Women's education:</b> Research and create an article on the importance of education for girls and women around the world. Explore the benefits of education, the challenges that girls and women face in accessing education, and the initiatives that have been implemented to promote education for all girls and women.	
<b>Women in sports:</b> Research and create an article on a female athlete who has made significant contributions to their sport. Explore their achievements, challenges they faced, and the impact they have had on their sport.	
<b>Women's rights around the world:</b> Research and create an article on the state of women's rights in different parts of the world. Explore the progress that has been made and the challenges that remain	
<b>Women in STEM:</b> Research and create a poster on a female scientist, engineer, or mathematician who has made significant contributions to their respective fields. Explore their work and their main successes.
