From Monday 15th May the uniform expectations for the remainder of the term are as follows:

Typical Summer Term Weather

- Students in Years 9, 10 and 11 should continue to wear their full school uniform every day. Specifically, students should always wear their blazer, a white shirt, a school tie, tailored appropriate length trousers or the Trinity branded skirt and black tights and formal leather black shoes. (no trainer type shoes, or Nike air force will be accepted)
- In the warmer weather, students may remove their blazers, but their shirts should remain tucked in. Students must wear their blazers to every lesson.
- A plain black jumper is optional and can be worn on colder days during the summer term.
- The only jumpers that will be allowed, are the Trinity branded v neck jumper or a plain black jumper with no logo. Any other jumpers are not permitted.

- I would like to stress that jumpers can only be worn in addition to a blazer and not to replace it.

AS FROM MONDAY 15TH MAY, IF STUDENTS ARRIVE AT SCHOOL WITH A HOODED JUMPER OR TRACKSUIT TOP EITHER OVER OR UNDER THEIR BLAZER, THEY WILL BE ASKED ONCE, TO PLACE IT IN THEIR BAG AT THE SCHOOL GATE. IF STUDENTS ARE SEEN WEARING A HOODED JUMPER DURING THE SCHOOL DAY, IT WILL BE CONFISCATED UNTIL THE END OF THE SCHOOL DAY. PLEASE CAN PARENTS/CARERS SUPPORT US IN ENSURING THAT STUDENTS UNDERSTAND THIS RULE AND NOT SEND STUDENTS TO SCHOOL IN HOODED JUMPERS OR TRACKSUIT TOPS AT ALL.

Extreme Hot Weather Conditions

- If there are any occasions this summer term where the temperatures are forecast to be extremely hot, I will communicate to parents/carers and notify you of my decision to allow students to wear full PE kit to school in an effort to remain cool and safe. This worked well last year and students have already requested an extreme weather uniform adjustment for this year which is both sensible and necessary. I will communicate with all parties as soon as this becomes necessary.
